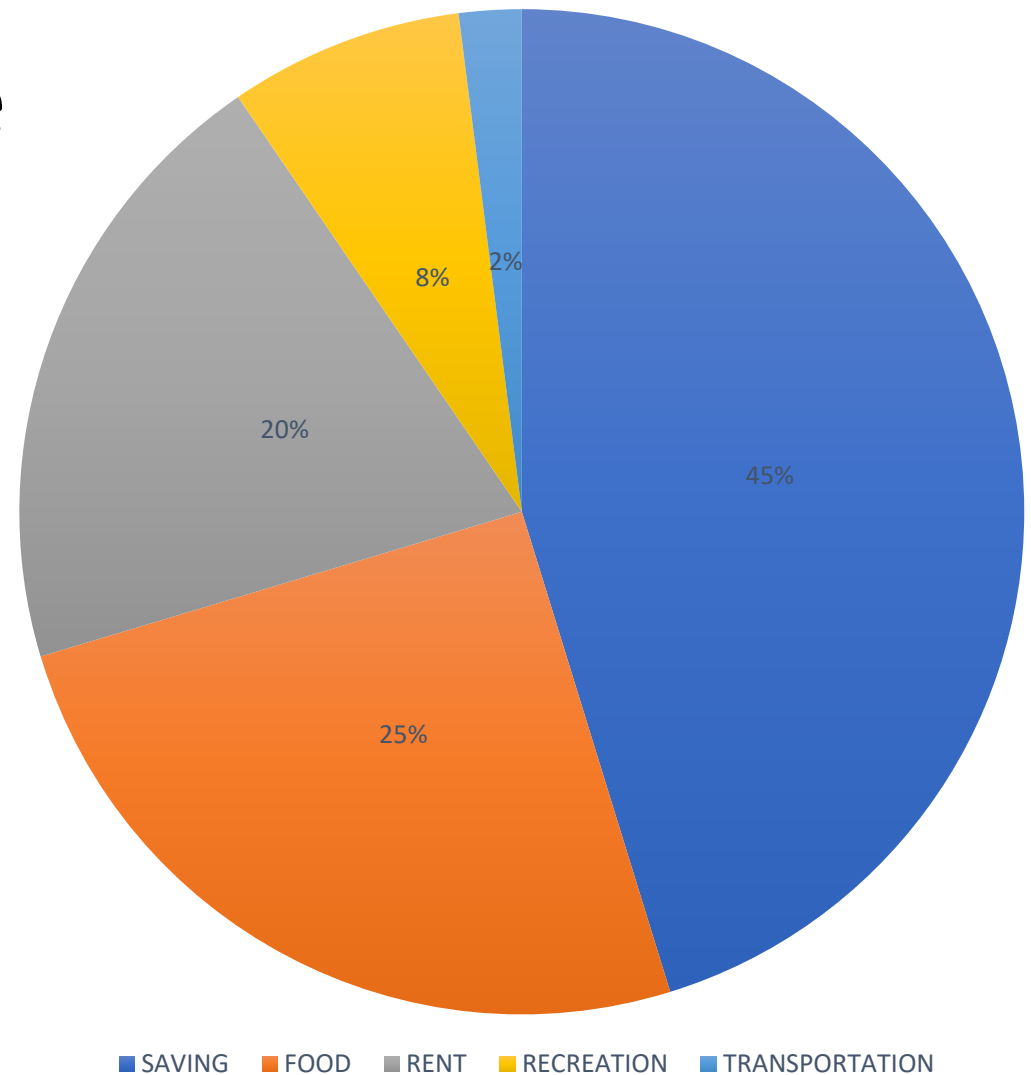

Private hospital

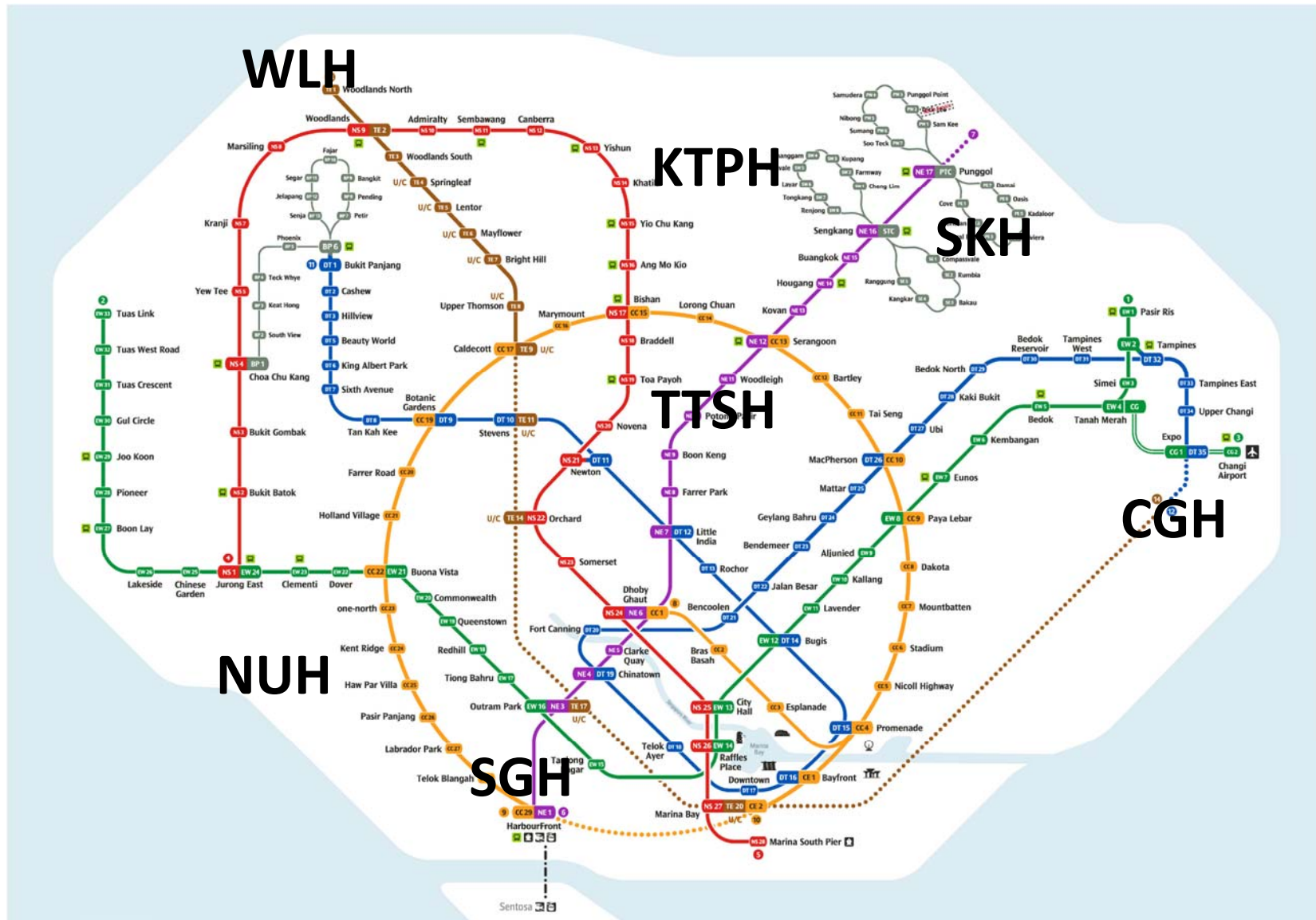
